Is exhibit 5 to be used as the sole FAA regulations? If not, what is the relevance/purpose of the Advisory Circular.	The Advisory Circular is an accurate representation of the FAA regulations. Cambridge Leone's knowledge and understanding of the regulations will need to be demonstrated during the course of the trial.
3	11/11	Exhibit #7 - Are we to draw any information from the 3 white boxes added to the center display? Are we to draw any information from the thumb placement on the controller?	Exhibit 7 demonstrates the location and position of the drone remote at the time of discovery.
4	11/14	Exhibits - Typos? #1. "Know" instead of "Known" #5 Guidelines for drones dated to 1988? Only refers to model aircraft, not drones #9 "Haring" instead of ""Hearing"" at top right of paper #11. Two "3"s in enumeration (no #4); Skipped a line in table "	Minor typos are to be considered as such, typos in the course of regular business and case creation. These items do not impact the Stipulation on page 4.
5	11/14	Exhibits - Typos? #4. Fourth paragraph is there a missing "0" in settlement amount?	The \$10,600 refers to the total calculation for pain and suffering, as explained by the remaining part of the sentence.
6	11/14	Will there be any additional law included in this case - like Jury instructions?	The case packet is closed and complete.
7	11/15	In regards to the autopsy (exhibit 10), it appears like there is contradictory information about the cause of death. On page one, it's listed that hypoglycemia was a contributing cause to death, on page 2 the blood glucose levels are listed as 28 mL/dL (which aligns with hypoglycemia), but on page 3 in "additional autopsy notes" it states that a "spike in blood sugar caused a cardiac event." This seems to suggest that the decedent suffered hyperglycemia prior to death.	Hyperglycemia is the technical term for high blood glucose (blood sugar).

There are 8 rotors. The 16 rotors quotes in the Leone statement should be "6 of the 8 rotors"
